LEGAL NOTICE**
Please take notice that the Town of Ridgeway will conduct a Public Hearing at the Town Hall for the purposes of considering for passage of

a Local Law #1 of 2015 entitled a Local Law to Amend the Town of Ridgeway Zoning Ordinance To Add Provisions Regulating LED (Light Emitting Diode) Signs.

Please take notice that the Public Hearing will be held on February 17, 2015 at 7:00 pm at the Town Hall of the Town of Ridgeway, 410 West Avenue, Medina, NY 14103. All persons interested in said proposed Local Law may attend at said Hearing. The substance of the Local Law is as follows.

**Local Law #1 of 2015
A Local Law to Amend the
Town of Ridgeway Zoning
Ordinance To Add Provisions
Regulating LED
(Light Emitting Diode)
Signs**

Section 1.
This Local Law shall be known as a Local Law Amending Section 600 of the Zoning Local Law of the Town of Ridgeway.

Section 2.

Article VI, Section 600, of the Zoning Local Law of the Town of Shelby, Orleans County, New York, is hereby amended by adding new provisions under subsection K which shall be numbered 5. and entitled LED (Light Emitting Diode) Signs which provisions shall read as follows:

5. LED (Light Emitting Diode) Signs

a. One such sign will be permitted per property.

b. The LED sign shall be erected as either a wall/facade sign or monument/ground sign. LED signs cannot be installed as a pole/pylon sign or freestanding sign.

c. LED signs will be subject to the same height, projection, clearance and set back provisions as wall/facade signs or monument/ground signs, depending on the LED sign's configuration.

d. There shall be no scrolling, animation or flashing of any message or portion thereof.

e. The static display time of each changeable message or image shall be a minimum of 20 seconds.

f. The maximum length of time between changes of messages or images shall be 10 seconds.

g. The change of message or image shall occur simultaneously for the entire sign face.

h. During daylight hours, the maximum illumination shall be 5,000 nits (or candelas per square meter), with a maximum illumination of 500 nits between dusk and dawn, as measured from the sign's face at maximum brightness.

i. There shall be a distance of at least 500 feet between LED signs, and at least 500 feet between an LED sign and the nearest existing residence, residential or agricultural district.

j. LED signs shall be subject to all of the other provisions of this Section 600, including but not limited to, permit procedures and design guidelines.

Section 3.

(a) This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the Office of the Secretary of State.

(b) If any part or section of this local law shall be held to be invalid, the remaining provisions thereof shall not fail but shall remain in full force and effect.

(c) All local laws, ordinances, rules or regulations, or parts or portions thereof that conflict or are contrary to any portion of this local law are hereby repealed.
