This Safety Improvement Project will install centerline rumble strips on 450 Miles of State highway in Genesee, Livingston, Monroe, Ontario, Orleans, Wayne, and Wyoming counties in high-speed locations. Centerline rumble strips have been shown to reduce head-on collisions on high-volume, non-divided, high-speed roads. This work will be done during 2015 and drivers should expect only minor delays due to construction on the affected roadways. The work zone will be similar to what drivers encounter when meeting a striping crew, with the exception that flaggers will be stationed with the work zone to allow an alternating single lane of traffic to pass while the work is done.

This letter is in accordance with USDA Rural Development Agency ("Rural Development") requirements and supplements prior legal services agreements and engagement letters for our professional services as bond counsel to the Town of Ridgeway, Orleans County, New York (the "Town") for these types of projects. This supplemental engagement letter relates to the authorization for the establishment of Water District No. 13, and the structuring and financing in connection with such establishment (collectively, the "Project").

Based on the Town's \$800,000 Project (and on the tentative plan of financing provided by Municipal Solutions that is identified below), our estimated fees will be in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$19,000. This amount is calculated with the understanding that the Town would issue two bond anticipation notes and one series of bonds through Rural Development within two years from the date of this letter. This amount also includes our fees for the substantial early work structuring and refining the Project to comply with Town law, and the establishment proceeding that was started by Board motion, but due to complications, was rescinded and initiated by the resident signature method.

We understand that the Town is looking to finance the Project through participation in attractive financing programs offered by Rural Development. Therefore our fee estimate has been increased to reflect the additional work related to such Rural Development financing programs.

Should the above assumptions change, any extraordinary factors present themselves or a more concrete plan of financing be established, we respectfully request that an amendment to this supplemental engagement letter be approved.

As you know, the State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) required an archaeological investigation for this project. We undertook the work to solicit requests for proposals and to coordinate and interface with the archaeologist to keep the project moving forward although the work was beyond the scope of the environmental services agreement between the Town of and our firm. We are requesting the Town Board's consideration for approving a fee of \$1,000 for this additional work we performed which included the following takes: which included the following tasks:

I have inspected 3652 Knowlesville Road, it is my opinion that the structure presents a danger to the health, safety, morals and general welfare of the public and is unfit for human occupancy. The structure is open due to a fire making it a place of rodent infestation. The partial basement is full of water, the power is turned off, there is no apparent source of heat, the structure has water damage with mold throughout the interior.

Taxes are two years in arrears, continued nonpayment will result in tax foreclosure in 2014

It is my recommendation that the structure be demolished.
